Memorial to the former Sachsenhausen Concentration Camp



...After a drive of about 1 hour through some northern neighbourhoods of Berlin and on the "Autobahn" (German Freeway), you will arrive in Oranienburg, the site of former Sachsenhausen Concentration Camp which was planned to be a model for many other camps and designed to be the first new concentration camp established in 1936.

In Sachsenhausen more than 200,000 people were imprisoned between 1936 and 1945.

Tens of thousands of people died of starvation, disease, and mistreatment and were victims of the systematic extermination operations of the SS.

<u>Please note:</u> your guide is entitled to take you only through certain parts of the memorial – An audio-guide tour is offered in English

(Euro 4.00/person to be paid at the Information Center of the Memorial).

Also note that the entire area is quite spread and walking on even ground (no steps to take) will be necessary of about 2 hours.

Due to the open terrain it might be quite windy in autumn and winter.
