Berlin Walking Tour: The Wall, Notorious Sights of the III Reich and Cold War

Duration: about 3 hours (Shorter tour possible on request)

Start at Berlins famous Brandenburg Gate and see with your private guide the Reichstag from the outside (German Parliament Building) with its famous glass dome (from the outside).

Wander through the Holocaust Memorial and, on request, you may have an inside visit of the Place of Information underneath the Memorial (admission free – Duration: about 30 minutes).

Next to the Holocaust Memorial you'll stay on top of the former site of Hitler's bunker (no inside visit possible) and will learn what happened during the last 3 days of Hitler's life...

Listen as your guide explains what happened here at the end of the war, and why there is nothing left to see.

You'll learn later on how 21st-century Berlin was taking shape on Potsdamer Platz and find out where the Nazi SS and Gestapo HQ stood.

Close by, you'll see an original remnant of the Berlin Wall and walk along the former "death strip", arriving at Checkpoint Charlie where you tour will end...

During your tour, your guide will explain how the Wall was built, as well as the momentous events of its fall in 1989.

Depending on duration and place of departure, the route may vary.

Please be aware that due to traffic conditions and streets closed due to reasons beyond our control, some places of interest may not be available.

We will try to replace them with an alternative.

Naturally your tour may be custom tailored and extended to suit your personal interests.
