3 hours Berlin Highlights Tour

Berlin is a fascinating city! Since the Berlin Wall began to crumble on that special night in November 1989, its two halves have slowly fused into something like the fascinating capital city of old.

This mainly panoramic tour will show you the highlights of both East- and West Berlin.

Drive alongside Tiergarten Park, pass the many new embassies and Victory Column, built after Prussian victories over Denmark, Austria and France in the 19th century. Admire the iconic landmark of destroyed William Memorial Church, a reminder against cruelty of War... Stop for photos of Brandenburg Gate and the Reichstag – monuments that have become symbols of post war times and the separation of Germany. Have a glance at the nearby most important memorial in Germany to the Holocaust: the Memorial to the Murdered Jews of Europe.

See the architectural highlight Potsdam Square before continuing to Checkpoint Charlie and to see on the way a remnant of the Berlin Wall, both poignant reminders of this once divided city.

Drive along the world-famous Unter den Linden Boulevard. Once considered Berlin's palatial avenue it has many fine buildings including the Alte Wache, the Russian Embassy, the Humboldt University, the Crown-Prince Palais and the Zeughaus (Armoury).

Have a glance at the Opera Square - where in 1933 the Nazi party held their infamous book burning and which is followed by Museum Island, the Red City Hall and Alexander Platz Square. Dominated by Berlin's 1,200-foot high TV tower, this square is the heart and centre of former East Berlin.
